

TOWN OF LAC DU BONNET


BY – LAW NO. 90/09

Being a by-law of the Town of Lac du Bonnet implemented to control the placement of mobile signs.


1. This By-Law may be cited as the “Town of Lac du Bonnet Mobile Sign By-Law”.
2. For the purposes of this By-law:
 - (a) “Development Officer” means the official of the Lac du Bonnet Planning District designated by the Town of Lac du Bonnet to enforce the provisions of this By-Law;
 - (b) “Designated Officer” means the Chief Administrative Officer for the Town of Lac du Bonnet or her designate; and
 - (c) “Mobile Sign” shall mean a sign which is not permanently affixed to a structure or the ground and which is designed for temporary use.
3. No person other than an individual or a corporation licensed under this By-Law shall place, erect or lease Mobile Signs within the Town of Lac du Bonnet.
4.
 - (1) The applicant for a Mobile Sign Contractor’s License (attached hereto as Schedule “A”) shall make application for such License to the Designated Officer in writing.
 - (2) The application for a Mobile Sign Contractor’s License shall contain the following information:
 - (a) if the applicant is a natural person: his name, address, the business location, the business mailing address and the business phone number; or
 - (b) if the applicant is a firm or partnership: the name, address and occupation of each of its members or partners, the business location, the business mailing address and the business phone number; or
 - (c) if the applicant is a body corporate: a Certificate of Good Standing from the Registry of Companies, the registered office of the Corporation, the business location, the business mailing address and the business phone number; and
 - (d) proof of liability insurance in an amount of not less than one million dollars.
5.
 - (1) The fee for a Mobile Sign Contractors License shall be \$25.00 per year
 - (2) A Mobile Sign Contractors License shall be valid for one year from the date of issue.
6.
 - (1) A permit shall be required for each Mobile Sign placed or erected on a site within the Town of Lac du Bonnet
 - (2) The fee for a Mobile Sign shall be \$5.00 per said sign per 30 day period to a maximum of six months.
- 6.1. Notwithstanding any other provision of this By-Law any person who owes outstanding fees to the Town of Lac du Bonnet for a by-law or regulatory violation for which he has been convicted shall not be entitled to a license or permit issued pursuant to this By-Law until such time as all such outstanding fines have been paid and proof of payment in a form acceptable to the Designated Officer, has been provided to the Designated Officer.
7. Every Mobile Sign shall:
 - (i) display the name of the Mobile Sign Contractor;
 - (ii) be of a design approved by the Development Officer; and
 - (iii) display an identification number.
8. A Mobile Sign shall only be placed on a site with the written permission of the site owner or jurisdiction responsible.

9. (1) The minimum permissible distance between Mobile Signs on a site shall be 12 meters (39.4 feet) as measured from the face or face edge of the Mobile Sign.
 (2) Only one Mobile Sign shall be placed on a site which has frontage of 12 meters (39.4 feet) or less.
10. A Mobile Sign shall be placed on a site which has frontage of 2 meters (6.6 feet) from the property line of a site as measured from the face or face edge of the Mobile Sign.
11. The Development Officer may refer to any application for a permit for a Mobile Sign to the Town's Designated Officer to ensure the Mobile Sign is placed or erected in such a manner so as to not create a sight distance hazard.
12. A Mobile Sign shall not contain symbols, slogans or lighting similar to that used for traffic control and warning.
13. (a) A Mobile Sign shall not be placed or erected in any Residential Zone unless approved by Council.
 (b) A Mobile Sign shall not be placed or erected at a Heritage Building unless approved by Council.
14. A Mobile Sign shall not be placed on Town owned property or on property over which the Town has jurisdiction unless approved by Council.
15. In addition to any other penalty provided for in this By-Law or the The Manitoba Municipal Act, a Mobile Sign placed or erected in contravention of this By-Law may be removed by the Town of Lac du Bonnet upon due notice, such period being in the sole discretion of the Development Officer, and the cost of such removal shall be at the expense of the Mobile Sign Owner.
16. Any person who contravenes the provisions of the By-Law shall be guilty of an offence and liable upon summary conviction to a \$50.00 penalty for each day the infraction exists.
