**Minutes of the special meeting held on June 3, 2011 @ 10 a.m. of Council called to discuss storm water issues regarding the Manitoba Conservation Building on Provincial Road 502.**

The meeting commenced at 10:09 a.m.

Mr. Massey advised that their storm water was being placed into the storm sewer. Public Works Supervisor Molinski explained the process and it was determined and agreed by all present that the whole area is draining into the Town sewer system and not into a storm runoff drain. Mr. Massey advised that Manitoba Conservation will have the water reverted to the run off drain rather than the sewer system by rerouting the piping to the catch basin/storm drain at the corner of Johnson Avenue and Provincial Road 502.

At this time Mr. Massey took all present outside to visual see how the system was presently working.

Manitoba Conservation will be forwarding Administration a request to extend the 30 day timeframe which the Town agreed would be extended to accommodate the works to be completed.

Public Works to have pictures of the project submitted to Administration for record keeping to be filed in the roll number file for future reference.
